### Season Fees

Market fees are for each stall. One group or farm per stall.

Sat. May 6- October 14	\$60.00
May 6 - July 22	\$40.00
July 29 - Oct. 14	\$40.00

Daily Rate	\$10.00

A vendor may set up to three times at a daily rate of \$10. After that they will be charged the season or segment fee.

**Please make checks payable to Richland Area Farmers Market** when returning the Application or you can pay the fees to the Market Manager when you first attend the market.

### Market Rules

- All items are to be homegrown, self-made or have value added to them. Vendors may not buy and resell items. Items sold in partnership with another person both must be listed on the application form.
- It is recommended that vendors provide sun shade to keep products at peak. Vendors may use tailgates on vans, trucks, or tables.
- Items sold must fit within a 10 x 10 space. Otherwise, request a second space.
- It will be the responsibility of the vendor to provide a high quality product and full measure. Low grade produce will harm future sales and lower prices. The Market Manager and/or committees may ask the vendors of known inferior merchandise to leave the market.
- RAFM Vendors compete on the basis of quality of product and customer service. Undercutting of prices will not be permitted.
- All items to be sold at the Richland Area Farmer's Market will be sold by legal weight or measure in Wisconsin. Any scales being used and items sold will be subject to the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture's Inspection.
- It will be the responsibility of the vendor to include proper labeling, weights, measures and proof of licenses where needed for each item sold.
- Vendors may arrive early to set up. You may claim your spot prior to 7A.M. on Saturdays. However, selling of products may not begin until 7:30 A.M.
- Vendors must keep the area clean of all types of refuse and clean up after each day's sales.
- No smoking in vendor booths.
- No soliciting permitted.
- The Richland Area Farmers' Market will not be responsible for any produce sold or for any accident that may occur. You are encouraged to have vendor liability coverage.
- To be a voting member of RAFM you must attend at least five market dates.
- The Market Manager's decision is final.

## Products Allowed

The following list is a guideline of what products may be sold. If you have something that you wish to sell and it is not listed here, contact the market manager BEFORE bringing it to the market to sell.

- All fresh fruit & vegetables, berries, rhubarb
- Flowers - fresh cut and dried
- Homemade soaps, lotions and creams
- Labeled maple syrup, sorghum, honey or apple cider. Jellies, jams and canned products per pickle law requirements.
- House and garden plants, flowers and bulbs
- Nuts, cracked or in the shell
- Herbs and mushrooms
- Homemade art, craft, woodworking items approved by the crafts committee only.
- ❖ Home baked items, seasoning mixes and processed foods from licensed establishments only.
- ❖ Meats and dairy products from licensed establishment only.
- ❖ Eggs from licensed establishment only.
- ❖ Requires retail and/or processing licenses
