- Fresh fruits & vegetables, berries, rhubarb
- Flowers — fresh cut and dried
- Maple syrup, sorghum, honey, and apple cider
- House and garden plants, flowers and bulbs
- Home-canned jellies, jams, sauces, and pickled vegetables
- Herbs and mushrooms
- Meats and dairy products from licensed establishments only
- Eggs from licensed establishments only

FOR YOUR COMFORT

- No smoking is allowed in vendor designated areas.
- Dogs and other pets are not allowed **anywhere within** vendor designated areas.
- No soliciting is permitted at the Market.
