SEASON FEES

Market fees are for each 10x10 space.
One group, business or farm per space.
If more space is needed, vendors may
rent another space.

FULL SEASON:

Wednesdays 1:30pm-5:30pm
May - October \$60.00

HALF SEASON:

Wednesdays 1:30pm-5:30pm
May - July \$40.00
August - October \$40.00

A vendor may set up three times
at the *daily rate of \$10*. After that they will be
charged for a half or full season.

MARKET RULES

- All items are to be homegrown, and grown by the vendor listed on your application, in other words, YOU. Vendors may not buy and resell items. Items sold in partnership must list all partners on application.
- It is recommended that vendors provide sun shade to keep products at peak. Vendors may use tailgates on vans, trucks, or tables.
- Items sold must fit within a 10 x 10 space. Otherwise, please request a second space.
- It will be the responsibility of the vendor to provide a high quality product. Low grade produce will harm future sales and lower prices.
- RAFM Vendors compete on the basis of quality of product and customer service. Undercutting of prices will not be permitted.
- All items to be sold at the *Richland Area Farmers' Market* will be sold by legal weight or measure in Wisconsin. Any scales being used and items sold will be subject to the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture's inspection.
- It will be the responsibility of the vendor to include proper labeling, weights, measures and proof of licenses where needed for each item sold
- Vendors may arrive no earlier than 12:30pm on Wednesdays to claim their spot. Vendors may not reserve their space.
- Vendors must keep the area clean of all types of refuse and clean up after each day's sales.
- No smoking in vendor designated area.

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- Dogs and other pets are not allowed **anywhere within** vendor designated areas.
- No soliciting permitted.
- The *Richland Area Farmers' Market* will not be responsible for any product sold or for any accident that may occur on the Market premises. All vendors are **required** to have vendor liability coverage.
- To be a voting member of RAFM vendors must attend at least five market dates.
- The Market Coordinator's decision is final.

PRODUCTS ALLOWED

The following list is a guideline of what products may be sold. If a vendor has something they wish to sell and it is not listed here, please contact the Market Coordinator **BEFORE** bringing it to the market to sell.

- All fresh fruits & vegetables, berries, rhubarb
- Flowers — fresh cut and dried
- Maple syrup, sorghum, honey, or apple cider, all appropriately labeled
- House and garden plants, flowers and bulbs
- Herbs and mushrooms
- Home-canned jellies, jams, sauces, and pickled vegetables appropriately labeled
- Meats and dairy products from licensed establishments only
- Eggs from licensed establishments only
- Individually wrapped and properly labeled soaps.
- Individually packaged baked goods, prepared according to the 'cottage laws.' (i.e. no dairy-based or other perishable toppings/fillings)

COVID-19 NOTES

- The Richland Area Farmers' Market is dedicated to the health and safety of its vendors and customers. We plan to follow the Center for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines for public behavior during our markets.
- Vendors are required to wear masks during the entire time at the market. Any helpers, staff, or family of the vendor **MUST** also wear masks. Vendors and their helpers without masks will not be permitted at the market. We want all to be comfortable and safe while at the market.
- While we do not require customers to wear masks, we do suggest that they do so to help others stay safe and healthy.
- Customers are asked to touch only the products they intend to buy.
- Giving out samples of any kind is prohibited.
- If you feel sick, have a fever, or test positive for COVID-19, we ask that you do not come to the market. We want you to be well.
